## Challenge

The security professional was met with several installation challenges that made completion much more difficult. The installer had a limited budget to work with for each surveillance system. In addition, he faced a time crunch, completing all four locations in two months from cabling to physically installing the cameras. Also, taking the time to establish line crossing VCA and integrate the system with an alarm siren should an emergency happen.

#### Solution

Advanced HD-TVI technology offered high quality images at an affordable price and was suitable for this project. The installer started with installing coax cables for 64 Platinum HD-TVI Turret Cameras 2.1MP, CMHT2122-28. It is very cost-effective and offers wide angle and full HD 1080P quality images. It also embodies a 2.8mm fixed lens for the best suveillance images. Images at night are no problem with 24 IR LEDs up to 65ft. The camera is easy to adjust utilizing UTC. The security professional also installed 16 Platinum HD-TVI Varifocal Motorized Lens Bullet Camera 2.1MP, CMHR6123DWA, which offers long range coverage for distance with easy control. multiple line crossing setup, both the Platinum Professonal Level 16 Channel HD-TVI 4.0 DVR and the Platinum Advanced Level 16 Channel HD-TVI DVR -Efficient Mode, LTD8316T-EA, were established. The recorders were placed in a back room where they'd be safe recording forensic evidence the cameras picked up from

the parking lots. LTD8316T-EA was compatible with the alarm siren should an incident occur. Thus, sending a push noticiation to the owner and manager's smartphones.
